

IDENTIFYING A 1400 SERIES A, B, C AND D

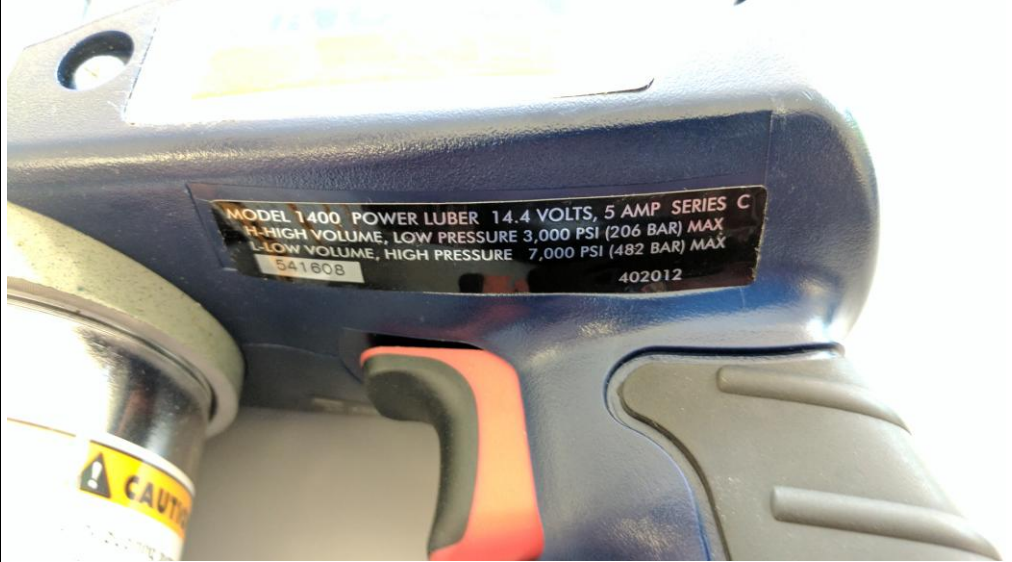
Before you purchase parts for your 1400 power luber, you want to identify the series that you have . Here are some tips for you.

How can a customer tell whether he has a 1400 series A, B, C or D Series Power Luber?
I have had 4 requests on this question in the last 2 days.

There should be a label near the trigger that will identify the model and series. this is assuming it is not worn off. See photo below.

Is there something on the Power Luber Handle that will say series A, or series B, or Series C or Series D.

1400 Series A and B

The A and B series are essentially the same, only minor parts changes. Breakdowns are attached for your review.

1400 Series C

Body of the gun was redesigned between the B and C series to include a pressure relief valve

1400 Series D

Additionally, if it was a gun purchased in the last year or so, the 1400 was changed again, and now there is a Series D. the Pressure relief was eliminated and a thermal protector was added to the wire harness to shut off the motor if too much amperage is drawn.

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
